

CITY OF SHULLSBURG
COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES
JULY 15, 2009
6:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shullsburg was held at 6:30 p.m. July 15, 2009 in the Community Room of the Shullsburg Community Townsend Center, 190 N. Judgement Street, Shullsburg, Wisconsin. Mayor Tom Curran called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Notice of the meeting was given to the official newspaper. Roll Call- Darrell Morrissey, Carl Ballard, Carol Korn, Dan Spillane. All present. Others present: Tom Lethlean, Dave Leahy, Carl Burgess and Janet Burgess.

Motion by Spillane second by Ballard to approve the minutes of the July 1, 2009 meeting. All aye, motion carried.

Committee Reports: Ald Korn reported the following items regarding the Utility Committee meeting: 1. Water Tower has been cleaned. 2. Lightning arrestor needs to be replaced due to lightning hitting the power line. George Morrissey has temporarily repaired the arrestor and when the new part comes in, the power will be shut down for approximately 1 ½ to 3 hours for installation. Citizens will be notified in advance of the power outage. 3. Lawn mower from Blackbourn's is on back order.

Ald Ballard reported that the Beer Garden Ordinance was discussed at a Police Committee meeting. It was suggested that a public hearing be held before the council considers the ordinance.

Ald Morrissey reported the following regarding a Park Committee meeting: 1. Water leak at pool. 2. Path to the Jackson Pavilion is completed. 3. The addition to the stage is completed. 4. The summer youth employee program maybe extended into September. 5. East Shelter house renovations will begin this week.

Motion by Ballard second by Morrissey to approve the bills for the general, water, sewer, electric, pool, museum and library funds. All aye, motion carried.

A brief discussion was held regarding amending the Badger Pool Policies to include guidelines for renting of the pool for private parties. Motion by Morrissey second by Spillane to amend the Badger Pool Policy as drafted. All aye, motion carried.

Future Agenda Items: SUN Facility Agreement, Garbage & Recycling contract and Setting date for public hearing for Beer Garden Ordinance.

1. Ald Spillane stated that the Fireworks in November should follow the same guidelines as the Fourth of July Fireworks. The person in charge of setting the fireworks in November will be contacting Spillane to discuss the matter. 2. Ald Spillane would also like to start working on the budget. 3. The city council extends a special thank you to all that contributed in the construction of the path to the Jackson Pavilion.
