COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 3, 2010

A special meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shullsburg was held at 5:30 p.m. September 3, 2010 in the Community Room of the Shullsburg Community Townsend Center, 190 N. Judgement Street, Shullsburg, Wisconsin. Mayor Tom Lethlean called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted and given to the official newspaper. Motion by Ballard second by Paquette to approve the annexation of all properties of Swiss Valley Farms Cooperative to the City of Shullsburg, all annexed property shall be in the designated manufacturing district and also grant an exempt to the present setback requirements for manufacturing districts by zoning code. Roll Call- Spillane- Yes, Paquette-Yes, Morrissey-Yes, Ballard-Yes. All aye, motion carried.
