

CITY OF SHULLSBURG
COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 4, 2006
6:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shullsburg was held at 6:30 p.m. October 4, 2006 in the Community Room of the Shullsburg Community Townsend Center, 190 N. Judgement Street, Shullsburg, Wisconsin. Mayor Lance McNaughton called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted and given to the official newspaper. Roll Call- Engels, Edge, Fink, Korn. All present. Jim Leech, Ed Faherty and Greg Faherty.

Motion by Korn second by Fink to approve the minutes of the September 21, 2006 meeting. All aye, motion carried.

Committee Reports: Ald Edge reported leave requests for Don Dickinson and Verne Jackson. Ald Edge also reported that a Utility meeting was held and the following items were discussed: 1. Water Utility will be flushing hydrants. 2. Water Utility will pull a new pump on the main tower.

Motion by Engels second by Korn to accept committee reports. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Edge second by Fink to approve the bills for the general, water, sewer, electric and library funds. All aye, motion carried. Regarding the Dubuque Chamber invoice presented at the last meeting, Ald Fink stated that the only benefit of joining the chamber was that the City of Shullsburg was listed on their website. It was decided that the city would not renew their membership with the Dubuque Chamber.

Motion by Korn second by Engels to go to number seven on the agenda. All aye, motion carried.

A discussion was held regarding the garbage and recycling proposals. Proposals were received from Allied Waste Services and Faherty Inc. Allied Waste Services proposed the following: 2007-\$13.66, 2008-\$14.07, 2009-\$14.50. Faherty Inc. proposed the following: 2007-\$9.43, 2008-\$9.70, 2009- \$10.00. Motion by Korn second by Engels to accept the proposal from Faherty Inc. Roll Call- Edge, Engels, Fink, Korn. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Engels second by Edge to set Trick or Treat hours on October 31st from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Fink second by Korn to approve an operator license for Susan Weiskircher. All aye, motion carried.

A discussion was held regarding having the Mine & Museum open for Cheesefest. It was decided that if they could find someone to work they would have it open for a few hours.

A discussion was held regarding the 2006 and 2007 budgets.

Steve Malone arrived. Malone discussed with the council current and projected economic trends.

During the public comment session of the meeting, Ald Korn inquired about the agenda for the meeting on October 11 regarding the casino. An agenda will be posted.

At 8:37 p.m. a motion was made by Engels second by Fink to convene in closed session pursuant to WI Stats 19.85 (1)(c) for the purpose of discussion the City Assessor and the property assessment. Roll Call- Edge, McNaughton, Engels, Korn, Fink. All aye, motion carried.

In closed session a discussion was held regarding the City assessor and the assessment of property.

At 8:48 p.m. a motion was made by Korn second by Fink to reconvene in open session. Roll Call- Engels, Edge, McNaughton, Fink, Korn. All aye, motion carried.
