

CITY OF SHULLSBURG
COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES
NOVEMBER 1, 2006

A regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shullsburg was held at 6:30 p.m. on November 1, 2006 in the Community Room of the Shullsburg Community Townsend Center, 190 N Judgement Street. Mayor Lance McNaughton called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted and given to the official newspaper. Roll Call - Edge, Engels, Fink, Korn. All aye, motion carried. Others present: Pat Byrne. Due to the absence of the Clerk, the minutes were taken by Pat Byrne.

Motion made by Fink second Korn to approve the minutes of the October 18, 2006 meeting. All aye, motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Alderman Engels reported leave requests for Verne Jackson, Ron Schardt and Pat Byrne. Motion made by Edge second by Engels to grant leave requests. All aye, motion carried.

Motion made by Korn second by Fink to approve the bills. All aye, motion carried.

A discussion was held regarding a community advertisement in the Telegraph Herald at a charge \$2500.00. Ten ads would be sold at a cost of \$200.00 each. The City would pay \$500.00. The ad would be published on Thanksgiving Day. Ads will have to be in by November 15, 2006. Motion made by Engels second by Korn to approve a contribution of \$500.00 toward the Telegraph Herald advertisement with a cost of \$200 to the businesses that wish to participate. Roll call - Edge, Engels, Fink, Korn. All aye motion carried.

Mayor McNaughton reported that Gretchen Jelenik, the city assessor, would not be finishing the assessing this year. He has contacted Bernard Wiegel who said that him and his associate would finish the assessing at a cost of \$7.00 per parcel. They will begin on November 13, 2006 notices of increases will go out on November 29, 2006. The Board of Review and Open Book will be on December 14, 2006. Open Book will be from 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Board of Review 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Motion made by Engels second by Edge to accept proposal. All aye motion carried.

Edge reported that he felt the park lights should be locked due to the fact that they have been left on leave one on the south side unlocked.

Korn reported that the Fourth of July committee would like to donate \$4,000.00 toward new bleachers in the park. They would like the money ear marked for bleachers, the rest of the money needed would be raised through fund raisers and the city would have no expense.

Motion made by Edge seconded by Korn to adjourn at 7:00pm. All aye motion carried.
