

CITY OF SHULLSBURG
COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES
NOVEMBER 15, 2006
6:30P.M.

A regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shullsburg was held at 6:30 p.m. November 15, 2006 in the Community Room of the Shullsburg Community Townsend Center, 190 N Judgement Street, Shullsburg, Wisconsin. Mayor Lance McNaughton called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted and given to the official newspaper. Roll Call- Engels, Edge, Fink, Korn- All Present.

Motion by Fink second by Korn to approve the minutes of the November 1, 2006 meeting as amended. All aye, motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Ald Fink reported that a Police Committee meeting was held. The following items were discussed: 1. December Schedule 2. Ordinance 8.03 3. Cell phone use. 4. Leave request for Officer Moyer.

Ald Edge reported leave requests for Verne Jackson. Motion by Korn second by Fink to accept committee reports. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Edge second by Korn to approve the bills. All aye, motion carried. The bill to Ayres associate was approved conditionally upon reimbursement from grant funds.

A discussion was held regarding city employees, as committee members, to attend meetings without having to use comp time, vacation time or personal time. Ald Engels inquired about whether or not the employees are paid to attend the committee meetings. Ald Edge stated that County employees are not allowed to attend committee meetings on county time. Aids Korn and Fink are not in favor of city employee attending committee meetings on city time without using their leave time. Mayor McNaughton suggested allowing city employees a certain number of hours per year to attend meetings without using their leave time.

A discussion was held regarding a memorial donation of a game table from the McKendrey Family. Ald Korn stated that the Gladys McKendry Family would like to donate a game table to be located either at the pool area or the museum area. There would be no cost to the city. The council welcomes the donation of the memorial as an asset to Badger Park.

Motion by Fink second by Korn to approve an operator license for Lisa Woodworth contingent upon a successful background check.

The clerk reported that she would like to attend SVRS training in Madison on November 29 & 30. Motion by Korn Fink to allow the clerk to attend the SVRS training in Madison. All aye, motion carried.

During the public comment session of the meeting, Ald Engels inquired about the concrete on Water Street. Ald Edge stated that the street department would be replacing a section of the deteriorating concrete.

At 7:15 p.m. a motion was made by Fink second by Korn to adjourn. All aye, motion carried.
