

CITY OF SHULLSBURG
COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
DECEMBER 29, 2010
6:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shullsburg was held at 6:30 p.m. December 29, 2010 in the Community Room of the Shullsburg Community Townsend Center, 190 N. Judgement Street, Shullsburg, Wisconsin. Mayor Tom Lethlean called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll Call- Darrell Morrissey, Carl Ballard, Dan Spillane, Jim Paquette. All present. Others present: Patricia Champion, Brad Wiegel and Marsha Einsweiler.

Motion by Ballard second by Paquette to approve the minutes for the December 15, 2010 council meeting. All aye, motion carried.

Committee Reports: Ald Darrell Morrissey reported that the Fourth of July Committee donated \$1,500 towards the cost of the mulch for the park. Ald Morrissey thanked the committee for the donation.

Motion by Spillane second by Paquette to approve the bills for the general, water, sewer, electric, library, pool, museum and TIF funds. All aye, motion carried.

A brief discussion was held regarding the temporary closing of Galena Street for a classic car and truck show. Motion by Morrissey second by Ballard to approve the temporary closing of Galena Street on May 22, 2011. All aye, motion carried.

Gary Weiskircher applied for a Class C – Wine and a Class B – Beer Only license doing business as Water Street Pub. Motion by Ballard second by Morrissey to approve a Class C – Wine and Class B – Beer only license for Gary Weiskircher. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Spillane second by Paquette to approve a contract with Delta 3 Engineering for Sanitary Sewer System Infiltration & Inflow Analysis for a cost of \$10,750. All aye, motion carried. The Utility Committee reviewed and approved the contract at the December 14, 2010 committee meeting.

Motion by Ballard second by Morrissey to approve a contract with Delta 3 Engineering for a cost of \$8,290. All aye, motion carried. The Utility Committee reviewed and approved the contract at the December 14, 2010 committee meeting.

Motion by Paquette second by Spillane to go to number 11 on the agenda. All aye, motion carried.

A brief discussion was held regarding the lights being left on at the park. Morrissey had obtained information regarding the electric costs of the flood lights from Laura Weiskircher prior to the meeting. The annual cost to operate the park flood lights is approximately \$200. Ald Morrissey will talk to George Morrissey about locking out 2 of the 3 lights.

Rich Wotnoske arrived.

A discussion was held regarding the NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) Ordinance. Rich Wotnoske and Brad Wiegel, Shullsburg Fire Department, discussed the issue of business owners not allowing them to do a fire inspection of their premises. This ordinance would adopt the NFPA Uniform Fire Code. Attorney Charles Kranz has reviewed the ordinance. Motion by Paquette second by Ballard to adopt the NFPA ordinance. All aye, motion carried.

Clerk/Treasurers Report- Einsweiler informed the council that a fire inspection had been completed at the city garage. A copy of the report which included items that needed attention was also given to the council.
