

8.05 SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL. (1) SIDEWALKS TO BE KEPT CLEAR. The owner or occupant of any lot or parcel shall promptly each day remove all snow and ice which may have fallen or accumulated upon the sidewalk in front of such lot or parcel, provided when ice has so formed that it cannot be removed, the owner or occupant shall keep the same sprinkled with a material which will prevent the sidewalk from being dangerous to pedestrians. If the owner or occupant fails to comply with this subsection, the Street Department may cause the snow or ice to be removed or sprinkled as required in this subsection, the cost thereof to be assessed against the property as a special tax.

(2) DEPOSIT IN STREETS RESTRICTED. No person shall cause to be deposited, snow from his premises onto the sidewalk abutting thereon or onto any street in the City without a permit therefore from the City Clerk/Treasurer, who may require payment of a fee sufficient to reimburse the City for the cost of removing any snow so deposited.
